- 1.4BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:
- 1.5Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2024, section 179A.07, subdivision 6, is amended to read:
- 1.6Subd. 6. **Time off.** A public employer must afford reasonable time off to elected officers
- 1.7or appointed representatives of the exclusive representative to conduct the duties of the
- 1.8exclusive representative and must, upon request, provide for leaves of absence to elected
- 1.9or appointed officials of the exclusive representative, to elected or appointed officials of an
- 1.10affiliate of an exclusive representative, or to a full-time appointed official of an exclusive
- 1.11representative of teachers in another Minnesota school district. Time off provided under
- 1.12this subdivision must not be used to engage in any political activities.
