Summary

This bill directs the Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) and the Metropolitan Council to request approval from the Federal Transit Administration to discontinue Northstar Commuter Rail service without any federal reimbursement. It requires legislative reporting on the request and federal response as well as a termination plan if the approval is granted.

Effective the day after enactment.
