**WRIT OF SPECIAL ELECTION**

**WRIT OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL A CERTAIN VACANCY IN THE  
OFFICE OF STATE REPRESENTATIVE OF HOUSE DISTRICT 52A IN THE  
COUNTIES OF ANOKA AND RAMSEY, STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND OF A  
SPECIAL PRIMARY TO NOMINATE THE CANDIDATES FOR THE  
SPECIAL ELECTION.**

To the People of the State of Minnesota, and particularly of House District 52A in the Counties of Anoka and Ramsey; to the Secretary of the State of Minnesota; to the auditors of the above-named counties; to all election officials in House District 52A and to all others who may be concerned:

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the office of State Representative from House District 52A of the State of Minnesota, caused by the resignation, effective June 18, 1995, of Representative Wayne Simoneau; and

WHEREAS, a special election to fill said vacancy is necessary to assure representation for the citizens of House District 52A:


NOW, THEREFORE, I, Arne H. Carlson, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting under the authority and direction vested in me by the Minnesota Constitution, Article IV, Section 4, and Minnesota Statutes Sections 204D.17 to 204D.27, 351.01, 351.055, and other relevant statutes, do hereby direct that:

1. A special election to fill said vacancy be held in House District 52A on Tuesday, July 11, 1995.
2. A special primary, if necessary, for the nomination of candidates for the office be held in House District 52A on Tuesday, June 27, 1995.




3. Affidavits and petitions of candidacy be filed with the Secretary of State from Tuesday, June 13, 1995, until 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 20, 1995.
4. Notices of this special election and special primary be given, that the nomination and election of candidates be conducted and that all things pertaining thereto be done as provided by Minnesota Statutes, Sections 204D.17 to 204D.27, and other applicable provisions of law.
