WRIT OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL A CERTAIN VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF STATE REPRESENTATIVE OF HOUSE DISTRICT 7A IN THE COUNTY OF ST. LOUIS, STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND OF A SPECIAL PRIMARY TO NOMINATE THE CANDIDATES FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION.

To the People of the State of Minnesota, and particularly of House District 7A, in the County of St. Louis; to the Secretary of State of Minnesota; to the auditor of the above-named county; to all election officials in House District 7A and to all others who may be concerned:

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the office of State Representative from House District 7A of the State of Minnesota, caused by the death on Sunday, July 11, 1999 of Representative Willard Munger; and

WHEREAS, a special election to fill said vacancy is necessary to assure representation for the citizens of House District 7A.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Jesse Ventura, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting under the authority and direction vested in me by the Minnesota Constitution, Article IV, Section 4, and Minnesota Statutes Sections 204D.17 to 204D.27, 351.01, 351.055, and other relevant statutes, do hereby direct that:

- 1. A special election to fill said vacancy be held in House District 7A on Tuesday, November 2, 1999.
- A special primary, if necessary, for the nomination of candidates for the office be held in House District 7A on Tuesday, September 14, 1999.
- 3. Affidavits and petitions of candidacy can be filed with the St. Louis County Auditor from Tuesday, July 27, 1999 until 5:00 p.m. on Tuesday, August 3, 1999.
