WRIT OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL A VACANCY
IN THE OFFICE OF STATE SENATOR
FOR SENATE DISTRICT 59 IN HENNEPIN COUNTY
AND OF A SPECIAL
PRIMARY TO NOMINATE CANDIDATES
FOR THE SPECIAL ELECTION

To the People of the State of Minnesota, and particularly of Senate District 59 in Hennepin County; to the Secretary of State of Minnesota; to the auditor of Hennepin County; to all election officials in Senate District 59; and to all others who may be concerned.

Whereas, there is a vacancy in the office of State Senator for Senate District 59 of the State of Minnesota, caused by the resignation of Senator Lawrence J. Pogemiller, effective November 7, 2011; and

Whereas, a special election is necessary to fill this vacancy to ensure representation for the citizens of Senate District 59.

Now, Therefore, I, Mark Dayton, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting under the authority and direction vested in me by the Minnesota Constitution, Article IV, Section 4, Minnesota Statutes 2010, Sections 204D.17 to 204D.27, 351.01, 351.02, 351.055, and other relevant statutes, do hereby direct that:

- 1. A special election to fill the vacancy will be held in Senate District 59 on Tuesday, January 10, 2012.
- 2. A special primary, if necessary, for the nomination of candidates for the office of State Senator for Senate District 59 will be held on Tuesday, December 6, 2011.
- 3. Affidavits of candidacy and nominating petitions for Senate District 59 must be filed with the Secretary of State or the county auditor of Hennepin County from October 31, 2011, until 5 p.m. on Wednesday, November 2, 2011.

- 4. Pursuant to Minnesota Statues 2010, Section 204D.23, subd. 5, affidavits of withdrawal for Senate District 59 may be filed with the same official who received the affidavit of candidacy until 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 3, 2011.
- Notices of this special election and special primary must be given, the nomination and
 election of candidates must be conducted, and all things pertaining thereto must be done as
 provided by Minnesota Statutes 2010, Sections 204D.17 to 204D.27, and other applicable
 law.
