IN CERTAIN COUNTIES.


Whereas, acting upon information that quail  
are in danger of undue depletion or extinction in the Counties  
of McLeod/<sup>Wright</sup>and Martin, State of Minnesota, and


Whereas, the Game and Fish Commissioner has  
investigated and is of the opinion that unless additional  
protection be given the quail in these counties this species  
will become unduly depleted,

Now, therefore, I, J.A.O. Preus, Governor of  
Minnesota, pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 134,  
Chapter 400, Session Laws of Minnesota for the year 1919, do  
hereby order that no quail be taken in the Counties of McLeod  
and Martin, State of Minnesota, during the season of 1924.

This order shall remain in force and effect  
until the close of the 1925 regular session of the Legislature  
of the State of Minnesota, unless sooner revoked or modified.
