EXECUTIVE DRAFTING

GOVERNOR'S ORDER NO. 3 (1927), RESPECTING PROTECTION TO MINNOWS
IN SAND, LITTLE SAND, TORTOSE AND BOX STRIP LAKES, ITASCA COUNTY.

WHEREAS, it has been represented to the Game and Fish
Commissioner that minnows are in danger of undue depletion in
the waters of Sand, Little Sand, Tortoise and Box Strip Lakes,
in Itasca County, State of Minnesota, and

WHEREAS, the Game and Fish Commissioner has investigated
and has presented me with the results of his investigation, and
has recommended that additional protection be given minnows in the
above named lakes to prevent their undue depletion.

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NOW, THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christensen, Governor of
the State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to authority
vested in me by Section 124, Chapter 100, S. L. Minnesota, 1919,
Sec. 5640, S. S. 1923, do hereby order that no minnows be taken
from the waters of Sand, Little Sand, Tortoise and Box Strip Lakes,
in the County of Itasca, State of Minnesota, for commercial pur-
poses or be bought, sold or transported for commercial purposes
during the seasons of 1927 and 1928.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the
1928 regular session of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota
unless sooner revoked or modified.
