ORDER RELATING TO THE TAKING OF MUSKRATS IN 1928.

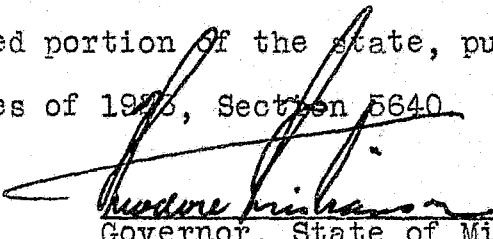
Pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 129, Session Laws of Minnesota for 1925, and upon recommendation of the Commissioner of Game and Fish of the State of Minnesota, I, Theodore Christianson, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby order as follows:

1. For the purposes of said act, the State shall be divided into two zones, the southern zone consisting of that portion of the state lying south of the north line of Township One Hundred Twenty-four (124) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, and south of the north line of Township Thirty-five (35), west of the Fourth Principal Meridian, the northern zone consisting of all that portion of the state lying north of the above described lines.

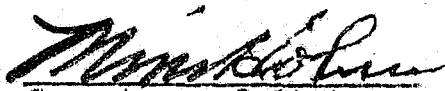
2. The taking of muskrats in any manner is hereby prohibited in each of said zones, except during the period from March 20th to April 18th, 1928, both inclusive, during which period the taking of muskrats in each of said zones, in such manner as is permitted by law, is hereby permitted.

3. This order shall be effective for the year 1928 only, and shall be subject to Executive Orders providing additional protection to muskrats in Waseca County and Nicollet County, issued this date, and to any other or further orders providing additional protection for muskrats in any specified portion of the state, pursuant to the provisions of General Statutes of 1925, Section 5640.
