
ORDER PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION FOR MUSKRATS IN WASECA COUNTY  
AND NICOLLET COUNTY.

WHEREAS, The Commissioner of Game and Fish of the State of Minnesota has investigated the necessity of providing additional protection to muskrats, and it appears that muskrats are in danger of undue depletion or extinction in Waseca County and Nicollet County, and that the additional protection hereinafter provided is necessary for the proper protection and propagation of muskrats in said counties, and to prevent the undue depletion and extinction thereof.

THEREFORE, I, Theodore Christianson, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to the authority vested in me by Section 5640, General Statutes of 1923, do hereby order as follows:

1. The taking of muskrats in any manner in Waseca County is hereby prohibited at all times.
2. The taking of muskrats in Nicollet County in any manner is hereby prohibited except during the period from March 20th to April 3rd, 1928, both inclusive, during which period muskrats may be taken in said county as otherwise permitted by law and by Executive Order.


This order shall be effective for the year 1928 only.
