ORDER RELATING TO THE TAKING OF MUSKRATS IN THE FEDERAL UPPER
MISSISSIPPI WILD LIFE AND FISH REFUGE.

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Whereas, pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 120,
Session Laws Minnesota 1923, and upon recommendation of the
Commissioner of Game and Fish of the State of Minnesota,
executive order No. 1, dated the 11th day of February 1929,
was promulgated whereby the taking of muskrats in any manner
was prohibited in the State of Minnesota, except for the period
of time from noon March 1st, 1929 to noon March 10th, 1929, and
Whereas it is recommended by Wm. E. Cox, Superintendent
of the Federal Upper Mississippi Wild Life and Fish Refuge, that
the season for the taking of muskrats in said Federal refuge be
extended from noon March 10th, 1929 to noon March 25th, 1929, and
whereas the recommendation is concurred in by the Commissioner of
Game and Fish

Now, therefore, the taking of muskrats by means of
trapping is hereby permitted in the Federal Upper Mississippi
Wild Life and Fish Refuge from noon March 10th, 1929 until noon
March 25th, 1929.

This order shall be effective for the year 1929 only
and shall be subject to any other orders providing additional
protection for muskrats in any specified area of the state
pursuant to the provisions of General Statutes 1923, Section
5540 thereof.
