

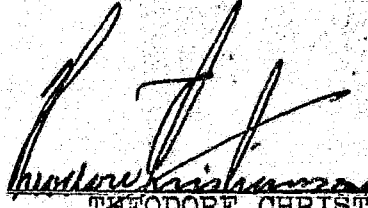

ORDER PROVIDING ADDITIONAL PROTECTION TO PARTRIDGE
OR RUFFED GROUSE, UPLAND PLOVER, WOODCOCK, GREATER
AND LESSER YELLOWLEGS FOR THE YEAR 1930.

Whereas, the Commissioner of Game and Fish of the Minnesota Department of Conservation, has investigated the necessity of providing additional protection for partridge or ruffed grouse, upland plover, woodcock, greater and lesser yellowlegs, and has found that these species are in danger of undue depletion,

Therefore, I, Theodore Christianson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, pursuant to authority vested in me by Section 5640, G. S. 1923, do hereby order that no partridge, or ruffed grouse, upland plover, woodcock, greater and lesser yellowlegs be taken or killed in this state during the year 1930.

This order shall remain in force until the close of the 1931 regular session of the Legislature of the State of Minnesota, unless sooner revoked or modified.
