WRIT AND PROCLAMATION REVOKING GOVERNOR'S
ORDER No. 13, DATED JULY 1, 1935

To the people of the State of Minnesota; to
the Secretary of State of the State of Minnesota;
to the Law Enforcement Officers of the Conservation
Department of the State of Minnesota; and to all
others whom it may concern: GREETINGS:

In accordance with the provisions of
Executive Order No. 13, duly issued and published
under date of July 1, 1935, I, Floyd B. Olson,
Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby
proclaim and revoke such order under and pursuant
to the authority vested in me as provided for
in Section 5640, Mason's Minnesota Statutes 1927.

FURTHERMORE, this order shall take effect
and be in full force from and after the date hereof.
