Whereas, it has been represented to the Director
of Game and Fish that deer are in danger of undue depletion
in the State of Minnesota, and

Whereas, the Director of Game and Fish has
investigated and has presented me with the results of his
investigation and has recommended the complete protection
of fawn in all of the counties of the State of Minnesota
during the year 1936, to prevent their undue depletion,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Hjalmar Petersen, Governor of the
State of Minnesota, by virtue of and pursuant to authority
vested in me by Section 5640, G. S. 1923, do hereby order that
no fawn or deer born in 1936 may be taken in any of the counties
of the State of Minnesota, in any manner during the year 1936.

This Order shall remain in force until the close of
the 1937 regular Session of the Legislature of the State of
Minnesota, unless sooner revoked or modified.
