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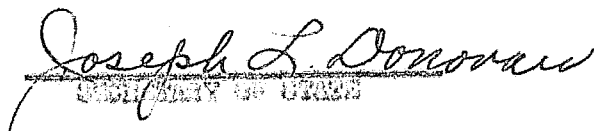
WHEREAS, it is the intention of the undersigned, Orville L. Freeman, Governor of the State of Minnesota, to depart temporarily from the continental limits of the United States for the purpose of visiting the European continent;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Orville L. Freeman, as Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue and authority of Minnesota Constitution, Article V, section 6, hereby declare that during such time as the undersigned is absent from the continental limits of the United States, the Honorable Earl F. Rolvaag, Lieutenant Governor of this state, may assume the duties and responsibilities of Governor, and shall be Governor during such period of vacancy, all in accordance with Minnesota Constitution, Article V, section 6.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-second day of July in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-five and of the State, the ninety-eighth.
