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The authority contained in Minnesota Statutes 1953, Section 10, is hereby declared to be in effect from August 20 to September 3, 1957 inclusive in order to meet the emergency with relationship to the enforcement of law and the protection of life and property of our citizens on the public highway of Minnesota. In conformity therewith, The Adjutant General will order to active duty detachments of the Minnesota National Guard to supplement and assist the forces of the Minnesota Highway patrol in the control of highway traffic and the prevention of injuries and death and the destruction of property on the public highway of Minnesota. The Adjutant General is further authorized to incur such expenses in connection therewith as he may deem necessary and advisable, including the cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of troops, all of which will be defrayed from the General Revenue Fund of the State as provided by law.
