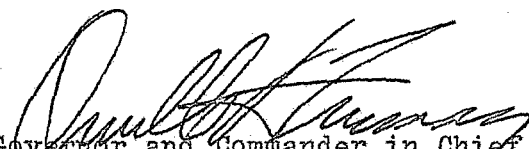

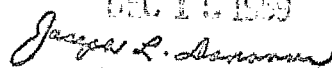

EXECUTIVE ORDERS
NUMBER 7

1. The Civil Authorities of the City of Albert Lea, Minnesota and Freeborn County, Minnesota, having advised me that tumults, riots and mob violence have occurred in the City of Albert Lea, Minnesota and that they have not sufficient forces available with which to restore and maintain order, accordingly I have declared that an emergency exists in said city. Now, therefore because of said emergency, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me, I direct and command The Adjutant General of the State of Minnesota to order to active duty such elements of the Military Forces of the State as are necessary for the protection of life and property and restoration of peace and of law enforcement in said community and county.

2. The cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of troops and other expenses involved will be defrayed from the general revenue of the State as provided by Minnesota Statutes 1957, Sections 192.49, 192.51 Subdivision 2, 192.52 and 192.54.
