

EXECUTIVE ORDER

To The Honorable Ernest S. Vandiver, Governor of the State of Georgia

WHEREAS, it has been represented to the Governor of Minnesota by William B. Randall, County Attorney, Ramsey County, Minnesota, that Jesse William Bryson, currently confined in the Whitfield County Work Farm, Whitfield County, Georgia, is an essential witness for the State of Minnesota in the kidnapping case of the State of Minnesota v. Rocco S. Lupino; and

WHEREAS, the Ramsey County Attorney has been advised by the Attorney General of the State of Georgia that it is necessary for the Governor of Minnesota to request of the Governor of Georgia by means of an Executive Order to take appropriate action to enable Jesse William Bryson to testify in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS, the Ramsey County Attorney has asked the Governor of Minnesota to initiate action to permit Jesse William Bryson to appear as a witness in the case of State of Minnesota v. Rocco S. Lupino, and has further agreed that all expenses relative to transportation of Jesse William Bryson from the Whitfield County Work Farm, Whitfield County, Georgia, to St. Paul, Minnesota, and return shall be borne by Ramsey County, Minnesota;

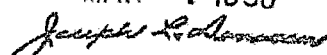
NOW, THEREFORE, I, ORVILLE L. FREEMAN, Governor of the State of Minnesota, hereby respectfully request the Governor of the State of Georgia to issue an Executive Order allowing the Sheriff of Ramsey County, Minnesota, or his representative, to receive into custody at the Whitfield County Work Farm, Whitfield County, Georgia, on or before March 14, 1960, the person of one Jesse William Bryson for the purpose of transporting Mr. Bryson to St. Paul, Minnesota, to testify in the above referred matter, and returning him to the Whitfield County Work Farm, Whitfield County, Georgia, upon the conclusion of his testimony.
