

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 10

ACCEPTING RETIREMENT APPLICATION OF THE HONORABLE
J. K. UNDERHILL AND EXTENDING HIS PRESENT TERM OF OFFICE

WHEREAS, The Honorable J. K. Underhill, Judge of the Sixth Judicial District, St. Louis County, Duluth, Minnesota, will attain the age of 70 years on June 15, 1967, and

WHEREAS, Judge Underhill has served as Judge of the Probate Court of St. Louis County, Minnesota, being a court of record, continuously from July, 1943, to November, 1950, and on June 15, 1967, will have served as Judge of the District Court, St. Louis County, for a period in excess of 16 years, and

WHEREAS, the six-year term for which Judge Underhill was elected on November, 1958, will expire January 4, 1965, which date is less than three years from the time when he would become eligible to retire under the provisions of M.S.A. Sections 490.101 and 490.102, and

WHEREAS, Judge Underhill has presented in writing his application for retirement stating his intention to retire upon eligibility pursuant to the provisions of said Section 490.101, Subd. 4; it is hereby

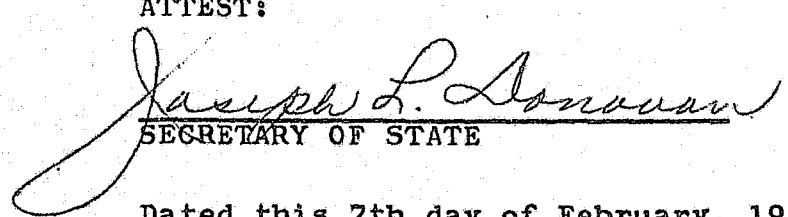
ORDERED, that Judge Underhill's application for retirement be accepted as submitted, and

ORDERED, also, that Judge Underhill's present term of office (expiring the first Monday in January 1965) be and hereby is extended to June 15, 1967, and

ORDERED, further, that a copy of this Order be filed in the offices of the State Auditor and the Secretary of State.

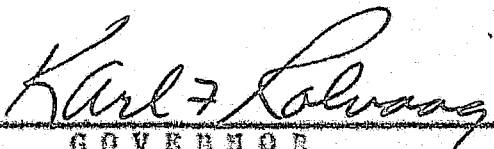
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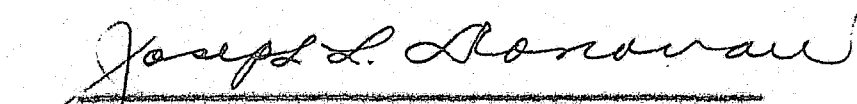
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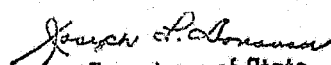
