

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 11

ACCEPTING RETIREMENT APPLICATION OF THE HONORABLE PAUL J. JAROSCAK AND
EXTENDING HIS PRESENT TERM OF OFFICE

WHEREAS, The Honorable Paul J. Jarosca, Judge of the Fourth Judicial District, Hennepin County, Minneapolis, Minnesota, will attain the age of 70 years on December 2, 1965, and

WHEREAS, Judge Jarosca has served as judge of the municipal court of the city of Minneapolis, Minnesota, being a court of record, continuously from May 23, 1945 to August 31, 1951, inclusive, and on December 2, 1965, will have served as judge of the district court, Hennepin County, for a period of 14 years, 3 months, and 2 days, and

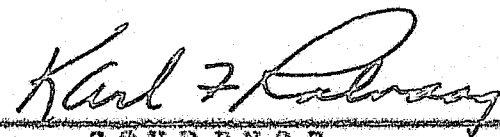
WHEREAS, the present six-year term for which Judge Jarosca was elected in November of 1958 will expire January 4, 1965, which date is less than three years from the time when he would become eligible to retire under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, Sections 490.101 and 490.102, and

WHEREAS, Judge Jarosca has presented in writing his application for retirement stating his intention to retire upon eligibility pursuant to the provisions of Section 490.101, Subdivision 4; it is hereby

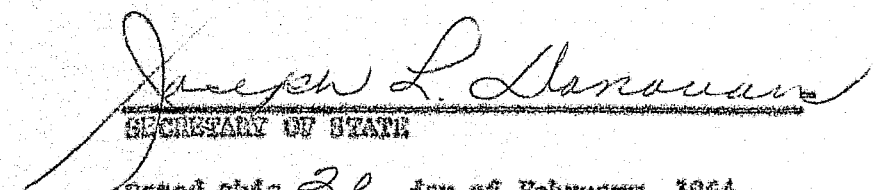
ORDERED that Judge Jarosca's application for retirement be accepted as submitted, and

ORDERED further that a copy of this order be filed in the offices of the state auditor and the secretary of state.

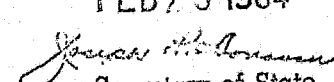
