EXECUTIVE ORDER 17
NUMBER

1. In accordance with provisions of Minnesota Statutes, 1961, as amended, Section 190.02, The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty, in service of the State, such elements of the military forces of the State as are required to alleviate emergency conditions caused by unusually heavy snow accumulations throughout the State. These elements will assist in emergency feeding of livestock, evacuation of civilians, and in any other field wherein life and property are endangered.

2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay, allowances of troops, and all other expenses involved will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State as provided for by Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 192.49, Subdivision 1, 192.51, Subdivision 2, of 192.52.
