

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 18

In accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes, 1961, as amended, Section 190.02, the Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty, in service of the State, such elements of the military forces of the State as are required to alleviate emergency conditions caused by tornadoes, which are being and have been suffered in various parts of the State. These elements will assist in protection of property, public and private; traffic control; evacuation of civilians; and in any other field wherein life and property may be endangered.

Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay, allowances of troops, and all other expenses involved will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Minnesota Statutes 1961, Sections 192.49, Subdivision 1, 192.51; Subdivision 2, 192.52.
