Emergency Executive Order 24-10

Providing National Guard Assistance to the State of North Carolina

I, **Tim Walz, Governor of the State of Minnesota**, by the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, issue the following executive order:

Hurricane Helene has caused widespread devastation across the southeastern United States, particularly in North Carolina. The storm has caused severe flooding, power outages, and destruction of homes and infrastructure. It has also left many displaced, which has exhausted local resources and hindered emergency response.

The storm's destruction has overwhelmed local emergency response teams, leaving communities without adequate resources to manage widespread damage. As part of its response, the State of North Carolina has requested assistance and support under the Emergency Management Assistance Compact. The Minnesota National Guard is uniquely positioned to provide immediate assistance to affected areas.

For these reasons, I order that:

1. The Adjutant General order to state active duty on October 2, 2024, the people, equipment, and facilities needed to support emergency operations in North Carolina.
2. The Adjutant General is authorized to procure the goods and services needed to accomplish the mission.
3. The Adjutant General is authorized to enter into supplementary agreements with the State of North Carolina as necessary to accomplish the mission, in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 192.89.
4. The costs of this assistance shall be paid from the general fund as allowed by Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 192.52.

This Executive Order is effective immediately under Minnesota Statutes 2023, section 4.035, subdivision 2, and remains in effect until National Guard resources are no longer required, or until November 1, 2024, whichever occurs first.

A determination that any provision of this Executive Order is invalid will not affect the enforceability of any other provision of this Executive Order. Rather, the invalid provision will be modified to the extent necessary so that it is enforceable.
