EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 7

21 July 1967

- 1. In accordance with provisions of Minnesota Statutes, as amended, Section 190.02, The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty in the service of the State, such elements of the military forces of the State as are required to aid local authorities, in the cities of Saint Paul and Minneapolis, in the quelling of civil disturbances therein. These elements will assist in the protection of property, public and private; in traffic control; and in any other field wherein life and property may be endangered.
- 2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of troops, and all other expenses involved will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Section 192.49; Section 192.51 and Section 192.52, Minnesota Statutes 1965.
