EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 14

23 May 1968

- 1. In accordance with provisions of Minnesota Statutes, as amended, Section 190.02, The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty during period 30-31 May, 1-2 June 1968, in the service of the State two (2) officers and twenty-five (25) enlisted men, of the military forces of the State, to supplement and assist forces of the Minnesota Highway Patrol in the control of highway traffic and in the reduction of injuries, death, and destruction of property on the public highways of Minnesota.
- 2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of troops, and all other expenses involved will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Section 192.49; Section 192.51 and Section 192.52, Minnesota Statutes 1965.
