

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20

ACCEPTING RETIREMENT APPLICATION OF THE HONORABLE
ARTHUR A. ACKERSON AND EXTENDING HIS PRESENT TERM OF OFFICE

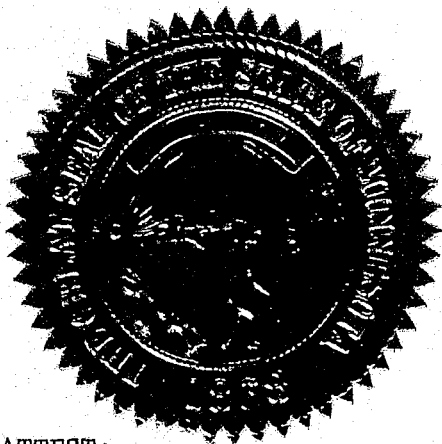
WHEREAS, The Honorable Arthur H. Ackerson, Judge of Probate and Juvenile Courts Grant County, Minnesota will attain the age of 70 years on June 8, 1970 and

WHEREAS, Judge Ackerson has served as Judge of said Probate Court continuously since January 1, 1949, and

WHEREAS, his present term of office will expire on December 31, 1968, which date is less than three years from the time when he would become eligible to retire under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Sections 490.11 and 490.12, and

WHEREAS, Judge Ackerson has stated in writing his intention to retire upon achieving eligibility for retirement on July 1, 1970 and has submitted his written application for extension of his present term of office pursuant to the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Section 490.12, Subc. 6;

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Judge Ackerson's application for retirement be accepted as submitted, and that his present term of office be and hereby is extended to include an additional period of time ending July 1, 1970. It is further ordered that a copy of this order be filed with the Secretary of State and the State Auditor together with a copy to the Honorable Arthur H. Ackerson.
