## EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 24 DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS excessive rainfall during the Month of June created flooding conditions throughout Roseau County and a subsequent rainfall of nine inches in a 24-hour period July 16 and 17, 1968, caused floods of devastating proportions, and

WHEREAS the destruction to public and private property has created a disaster of major proportions in Roseau County, and

WHEREAS excessive damage has been caused to roads and bridges throughout the County, to municipal utilities, and protective dikes and dams,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by authority granted me by the statutes of the State of Minnesota, do hereby declare a state of emergency to exist in Roseau County.
