EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 25 DECLARATION OF EMERGENCY

WHEREAS unseasonable heavy rains throughout much of the State of Minnesota during the months of August, September, and October, causing flooding conditions, delaying the harvesting of crops, and in some areas destroying crops thereby resulting in severe economic losses to the agricultural community; and

WHEREAS destruction to public and private property has created a disaster of major proportions,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Harold LeVander, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by the authority invested in me, do hereby declare a State of Emergency to exist, and direct the agencies of the State of Minnesota in cooperation with appropriate Federal agencies, to provide such aid to the stricken area as provided for under existing State and Federal statutory authority.
