- 1. In accordance with provisions of Minnesota Statutes, as amended, Section 190.02, The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty, in the service of the State, such elements of the military forces of the State as are required to aid civilian agencies in searching for a lost girl in the vicinity of Leech Lake in Cass County, Minnesota.
- 2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowance of troops, and all other expenses involved will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49, Subdivision 1, 192.51; Subdivision 2, 192.52.
