## Executive Order No. 47

In accordance with the authority vested in me by Minnesota Statutes 1967, Section 124.62, Clause (18), I hereby accept the provisions of P.L. 90-35, the Higher Education Act, Title V, Park B, Subpart 2, so that the State Board of Education may administer this federally funded program designed to meet the critical shortage of adequately trained education personnel pending further action by the 1971 Minnesota Legislature.

It shall be the responsibility of the Minnesota State Board of Education to adopt a state plan so that the available federal funds may be utilized to the fullest extent by the State of Minnesota in implementing the purposes of Title V, Part B, Subpart 2.

Available federal funds for the state administration of this act may be used for employment of necessary personnel in the Department of Education through classified or unclassified state service or by contract for the period of time that the federal funds continue to be available therefor pending further action by the 1971 Minnesota Legislature.
