EXECUTIVE ORDER

No. 48

August 6, 1969

1. In accordance with provisions of Minnesota Statutes, as amended, Section 190.02, The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty, in the service of the State, such elements of the military forces of the State as are required to aid civilian agencies in searching for a lost man in the vicinity of Tofte, in Cook County, Minnesota.

2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of troops, and all other expenses involved will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49; Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.
