

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 63

Providing for the administration of the "Law Enforcement Crime Prevention Program"

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, the Governor's Commission on Crime Prevention and Control has been established, and is presently operating pursuant to Executive Order No. 3, dated May 27, 1971; and,

WHEREAS, the Governor's Commission on Crime Prevention and Control is empowered to formulate policies and programs to foster and improve law enforcement in this State, and to administer certain said programs; and,

WHEREAS, the Governor's Commission on Crime Prevention and Control has formulated a program for crime awareness entitled "Law Enforcement Crime Prevention Program";

NOW, THEREFORE, I order that:


1. The administration of said "Law Enforcement Crime Prevention Program," including all functions necessary for or incident to said administration, shall be by the Governor's Commission on Crime Prevention and Control;
2. The administration of any contracts entered into by the State to implement said "Law Enforcement Crime Prevention Program" shall be by the Governor's Commission on Crime Prevention and Control.


This Order shall be effective on the date of signature.
