I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby issue this Executive Order in regard to the establishment of a Steering Committee for the Minnesota Criminal Information System (MINCIS):

The MINCIS Steering Committee shall be composed of the following members:

1. Members from each of the following, to be selected by the Commissioner of each:

Commission on Crime Prevention and Control Department of Administration. Department of Corrections
Department of Public Safety

- 2. Four (4) local government members to be selected by the Governor and to be representative of courts (1), corrections (1), and law enforcement (2). Two of these members shall reside in the seven-county metropolitan area and two shall reside outside this metropolitan area. One of these members shall be designated by the Governor as Chairman of the Committee.
- 3. One (1) member from the Minnesota Supreme Court or Court Administrator to be designated by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.

The powers and duties of the MINCIS Steering Committee shall be as follows:

- 1. Establish MINCIS objectives, plans, and specific programs to attain a comprehensive, integrated information system for criminal justice for the State of Minnesota.
- Develop an integrated budget for the maintenance and operation of MINCIS, including state and federal funding.
- Recommend to the Commissioner of Administration, when desirable, improvements or revisions in MINCIS computerization.

- 4. Establish security and privacy requirements for MINCIS.
- 5. Establish policies, regulations, and pricing for regional and local government interface to MINCIS and for providing criminal justice information service to local governments.
