WRIT OF SPECIAL ELECTION TO FILL VACANCY IN THE OFFICE OF STATE REPRESENTATIVE OF DISTRICT 12A WITHIN THE COUNTIES OF MORRISON AND TODD, STATE OF MINNESOTA, AND OF SPECIAL PRIMARY ELECTION TO NOMINATE CANDIDATES FOR SAID OFFICE.

To the People of the State of Minnesota and particularly of the Legislative District 12A within the counties of Morrison, and Todd; to the Secretary of the State of Minnesota; to the County Auditors of the above-named Counties; to all Election Officials of said District 12A; and to all others who may be concerned - Greetings:

WHEREAS, a vacancy now exists in the office of State Representative from District 12A of the State of Minnesota, caused by the death of the Representative, the Honorable Melvin J. Miller, and

WHEREAS, a special election to fill said vacancy is necessary to permit the person elected to take office at the opening of the next session of the legislature,

NOW, THEREFORE, I, WENDELL R. ANDERSON, AS GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, acting under the authority and direction of Minnesota Constitution Art. IV sec. 17 and Minn. Stat. 1971 Sections 203.44 to 203.55 and other relevant statutes do hereby direct:

- that a special election to fill the vacancy be held in Legislative District 12A on Monday, the 23rd day of December, 1974;
- (2) that a special primary election for the nomination of candidates for the office be there held on Monday, the 9th day of December, 1974;
- (3) that affidavits of candidacy must be duly filed on or before Monday, the 2nd day of December, 1974;
- (4) that the notices of this special election and special primary election be given, that the nomination and election of candidates and the conduct of these elections be had and all things pertaining thereto be done as provided by Minn. Stat. 1971 Sections 203.44 to 203.55 and other applicable provisions of law.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed and have hereunto set my hand at the Capitol, in the City of St. Paul, Minnesota this 25th day of November, 1974.
