

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 101

Providing for assistance to
officials of Watonwan County,
Minnesota

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, officials of Watonwan County, Minnesota, request search assistance in order to locate a missing person:

NOW THEREFORE, I order that:

1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty in the service of the state, such elements of the military forces of the state as required to aid civilian agencies in searching for a missing person in Watonwan County, Minnesota; and that
2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of said individuals will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the state, as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49; Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.


This Order shall be effective on 22 February 1975.


