

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 105

Providing for the establishment  
of the Governor's Office of  
Volunteer Services.

I Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota,  
by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution  
and applicable statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, it is vital in State Government to provide the  
best possible service to the people of the State of Minnesota;  
and

WHEREAS, the effective coordination of volunteer programs  
both public and private is necessary to provide the best  
possible service; and

WHEREAS, there exists within the State of Minnesota a  
vast reservoir of uncommitted human energies and resources  
that are seeking ways to improve the conditions of life for  
Minnesota's citizens through voluntary action; and

WHEREAS, there exists the need to establish within  
Minnesota at the highest level of Government an office that  
can channel, coordinate, and commit the vigor, vision and  
idealism that is exemplified by our many volunteer action  
organizations and activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I order that:

1. There be established an office of  
Volunteer Services within the Office  
of the Governor, with a director  
who shall be responsible to the  
Governor in carrying out the work  
of the Office;
2. There be provision of appropriate  
administrative arrangements for the  
Governor's Office of Volunteer  
Services within the regulations and  
guidelines established for the Office  
of the Governor;

3. All State departments and agencies cooperate with the Governor's Office of Volunteer Services to provide the best possible service to the people of the State of Minnesota.

This order shall be effective on the date of signature.
