

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 110

Providing for assistance to officials of St Louis and Lake Counties, and the State of Minnesota

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, officials of St Louis and Lake Counties, and the State of Minnesota request support in selection of a taconite tailings disposal site:

NOW THEREFORE, I order that:


1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty in the service of the state, such elements of the military forces of the state as required to support and expedite the selection by the State of Minnesota of an emergency taconite tailing disposal area in St Louis and Lake Counties; and that
2. Cost of subsistence, transportation, pay and allowances of said individuals will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the state, as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49; Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.

This Order shall be effective on 23 May 1975.
