Amending Executive Order No. 118 which establishes an Occupational Information System, by adding to the membership of the Board, by creating an Executive Committee, and by designating a Chairperson.

I, Wendell R. Anderson, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, do hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 118 establishes a governing board for the Minnesota Occupational Information System (MOIS); and

WHEREAS, it now appears that the purposes of MOIS can be better accomplished through the participation of two major agencies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I order Executive Order No. 118 be amended as follows:

- 1. Paragraph 3: the Commissioner of Administration and the Commissioner of Personnel, or their respective designees, are added as voting members to the MOIS Board.
- 2. Paragraph 3 is further amended by designating the Director of the Governor's Manpower Office as chairperson of the MOTS Board.
- 3. There is created an Executive Committee of the MOIS Board consisting of the following members or their designees:
 - (a) Director, Governor's Manpower Office; chairperson
 - (b) Commissioner of Administration
 - (c) Commissioner of Personnel
 - (d) Two other members of the Board selected by the Board

The Executive Committee shall act as a screening committee concerning MOIS personnel and shall make its recommendation to the Board on all personnel questions; it shall further act on behalf of the Board when this Board is not convened.

This Order shall be effective on the date of signature.
