

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 120

Providing for assistance to
officials of Douglas, Otter Tail
and Grant Counties

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, officials of Douglas, Otter Tail and Grant Counties request assistance in spraying mosquito disinfectants to deter spread of encephalitis;

NOW THEREFORE, I order that:

1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty in the service of the state, such elements of the military forces of the state as required to assist in spraying mosquito disinfectants to deter the spread of encephalitis; and that
2. Cost of subsistence, transportation and fuel, and pay and allowances of said individuals will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49; Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.


This Order shall be effective on 5 August 1975.
