

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 124

Repealing certain Executive Orders

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable Statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, the federal Office of Economic Opportunity has been dissolved, and

WHEREAS, in the interest of checking the proliferation of state agencies, the goals of OEO can be accomplished with equal or greater effectiveness within another, existing agency, and

WHEREAS, a number of other Executive Orders pertaining to other issues have been superceded by time, law or subsequent Executive Orders:

NOW, THEREFORE, I order:

- 1. Executive Order No. 11, issued October 20, 1971, to be repealed in conjunction with Executive Order No. 125;
- 2. the following Executive Orders to be repealed:
