

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 98

Providing for assistance to
officials of the State of
Minnesota

I, Wendell R. Anderson, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, officials of the State of Minnesota, request assistance to alleviate emergency conditions caused by a blizzard:

NOW THEREFORE, I order that:

1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota will order to active duty in the service of the state, such elements of the military forces of the state as are required to alleviate emergency conditions caused by a blizzard which struck the state on January 10, 1975. These elements will assist civil authorities as may be necessary; and in any other field wherein life and property may be endangered.
2. Cost of subsistence, transportation and fuel, pay and allowances of said individuals will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the State, as provided for by Minnesota statutes, Section 192.49; Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.

This Order shall be effective on January 10, 1975.


