



EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 139

Providing for assistance to
Officials of Polk County

I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota,
by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution
and applicable statutes, do hereby issue this Executive
Order:

WHEREAS, officials of Polk County request assistance
in a search for lost persons in the vicinity of Crookston;
and,

WHEREAS, the severity of the snowstorm and gusting
winds preclude an effective search within available
resources of Polk County:

NOW, THEREFORE, I order:


1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota to order to
active duty on and after 27 January 1977, in

the service of the state, such elements of the military forces of the state as required, and for such period of time necessary to successfully complete a search for the lost persons.

2. Cost of subsistence, transportation and fuel, and pay and allowance of said individuals will be defrayed from the General Revenue of the state as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49, Subdivision 1; Section 192.51 and Section 192.52.

This order shall be effective immediately and shall remain in force until May 1, 1977.
