



EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 81-8,

PROVIDING FOR EMERGENCY  
ASSISTANCE TO COUNTY  
OFFICIALS OF MINNESOTA

I, ALBERT H. QUIE, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, do hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, officials of St. Louis County of Minnesota have requested assistance in the search for a missing airplane; and

WHEREAS, the dense brush and natural cover contained in the area in which the airplane is presumed lost precludes an effective search within available resources of St. Louis County officials;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Order:


1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota shall order to active duty on and after August 8, 1981, in service of the State such elements of the military forces of the State as are necessary to assist local officials in the search for

the missing airplane. Those forces shall be utilized for such a reasonable period of time as is necessary to complete a thorough search for the missing airplane.

2. The costs of subsistence, transportation, fuel, and pay and allowances of individuals ordered to active duty by the Adjutant General shall be defrayed from the general fund of the State as provided for in Minnesota Statutes 1980, Sections 192.49, Subdivision 1; 192.51, Subdivision 2; and 192.52.


This Order is retroactively effective to August 7, 1981, and shall remain in force until such date as elements of the military forces of the State are no longer required in the judgment of the Adjutant General.
