

EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 84-4 Providing for Assistance to Officials of

Polk and Renville Counties

I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, the Sheriffs of Polk and Renville Counties requested assistance in rescuing stranded travelers; and

WHEREAS, extreme weather conditions prevented county officials from rescue of stranded travelers with county vehicles and equipment;

NOW, THEREFORE, I Order:

- A state of emergency is hereby declared to exist in the counties of Polk and Renville.
- 2. The Adjutant General of Minnesota shall order to active duty on and after February 4, 1984, in the service of the State,

such elements of the military forces of the State as are necessary to protect the health and safety of our citizens. These forces shall be utilized for such period of time as is necessary to successfully achieve those purposes.

3. The costs of subsistence, transportation, fuel, and pay and allowances of said individuals in the military forces of the State shall be defrayed from the General Fund of the State as provided for by Minnesota Statutes, Section 192.49; Subdivision 1, Section 192.51; and Section 192.52.

This emergency Executive Order, which is issued for the health and safety of the citizens of Polk and Renville Counties, shall be effective retroactive to February 4, 1984, and shall remain in force until such date as the emergency conditions are relieved.
