

EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 88-6
PROVIDING CLEAN DRINKING WATER TO THE
RESIDENTS OF WATERVILLE, MINNESOTA

I, RUDY PERPICH, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and applicable statutes, do hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, the Sheriff of LeSueur County, Minnesota has requested assistance in providing clean drinking water for the residents of Waterville, Minnesota due to a broken watermain; and

WHEREAS, the City of Waterville and other local officials have exhausted all other resources in their efforts to provide safe drinking water for the residents of Waterville, Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby order that:

1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota order to active duty on or after May 14, 1988, in service of the State, such elements and equipment of the military forces of the State as required to provide drinking water to the residents of Waterville, Minnesota and for such a period of time necessary to ensure the safety of our citizens.


- 2. The cost of subsistence, transportation, fuel, and pay and allowances of said individuals shall be defrayed from the general fund of the State as provided for in Minnesota Statutes 1987 Sections 192.49, Subdivision 1; 192.51 and 192.52.

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1987, Section 4.035, this Order shall be effective May 14, 1988 and shall remain in effect until such date as elements of the military forces of the State are no longer required.


