EXECUTIVE ORDER 91-29 PROVIDING FOR A GOVERNOR'S PLANNING COUNCIL ON DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES AND ASSIGNING RESPONSIBILITY TO THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION; RESCINDING EXECUTIVE ORDER 87-9

I, ARNE H. CARLSON, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the applicable statutes, do hereby issue this Executive Order:

WHEREAS, provision of services to persons with developmental disabilities is of concern and importance to the state; and

WHEREAS, no state agency has been designated by law to apply for, to receive, to accept, and to expend federal funds for such purposes;

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby order that:

 In accordance with Public Law 101-496 there be established the Governor's Planning Council on Developmental Disabilities, whose responsibility it shall be to supervise the development of a three-year state plan describing the quality, extent and scope of needed services being provided or to be provided to persons with developmental disabilities, to monitor and evaluate the implementation of the state plan, and to review state service plans for persons with developmental disabilities.

- Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1990, Section 4.07, the Department of Administration be designated the state agency to act for the Governor in applying for, receiving, accepting and expending federal funds granted to the State of Minnesota by Public Law 101-496.
- 3. The Department of Administration be designated as the responsible agency to provide staff and other administrative assistance to the Governor's Planning Council on Developmental Disabilities and to carry out all other responsibilities relating to the developmental disabilities program as required under state and federal law.

This Order rescinds Executive Order 87-9.

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1990, Section 4.035, subd. 2, this Order shall be effective fifteen (15) days after publication in the <u>State Register</u> and filing with the Secretary of State and shall remain in effect until rescinded by proper authority or it expires in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1990, Section 4.035, subd. 3.
