

EMERGENCY EXECUTIVE ORDER 95-5 PROVIDING FOR ASSISTANCE TO OFFICIALS IN GOODHUE COUNTY

I, ARNE H. CARLSON, GOVERNOR OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the applicable statutes, do hereby issue this Emergency Executive Order:

WHEREAS, the Sheriff of Goodhue County, Minnesota, has requested assistance in searching for a missing three-year-old girl; and

WHEREAS, Goodhue County does not have adequate personnel and equipment for an effective search;

NOW, THEREFORE, I hereby order that:

- 1. The Adjutant General of Minnesota order to state active duty on or about June 29, 1995, in the service of the State, such personnel and equipment of the military forces of the State as required, and for such a period of time as necessary, to assist and support the Goodhue County Sheriff in searching for the lost child.
- 2. The cost of subsistence, transportation, fuel, pay, and allowance of said individuals shall

be defrayed from the general fund of the State, as provided for in Minnesota Statutes 1994, Sections 192.49, subd. 1, 192.51 and 192.52.

Pursuant to Minnesota Statutes 1994, Section 4.035, subd. 2, this Order is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until rescinded by proper authority or it expires in accordance with Minnesota Statutes 1994, Section 4.035, subd. 3.
