Page 1, after line 20, insert:

"Sec. 2. **EFFECTIVE DATE.** 

Section 1 is effective the day following final enactment."

Amend the title accordingly

The **MOTION PREVAILED** and the amendment was adopted.

Senator Koering moved that S.F. 930, as amended, be recommended to pass to the Finance Committee. The **MOTION PREVAILED**.
