Dear Senator Langseth:

The Higher Education Budget Division recommends that the bonding projects described in the requests put forth by the University of Minnesota and the Minnesota State Colleges and Universities be included in the 2006 Capital Investment Bill. These projects were reviewed by the systems and ranked accordingly; therefore, we recommend full funding of all the projects and initiatives and full funding of HEAPRA.

Additionally, we recommend that authorization be granted to MnSCU to construct an academic building in Mankato (SF 2716-Hottinger) and that authorization be granted to the University of Minnesota to establish the Minnesota Biomedical Sciences Research Facilities Authority and the biomedical sciences research project funding program (SF 3044-Cohen).

If there is insufficient bonding capacity to cover all the requests, it is our recommendation that the Capital Investment Committee adheres to the priorities of the institutions and cut from the bottom of the lists.
