2 Senate as follows:

3 A new Rule 12.12 is added to read:

4 12.12 A bill that includes a transfer of money from the  
5 health care access fund to the general fund, or that includes an  
6 appropriation from the health care access fund for purposes  
7 beyond the scope of those for which appropriations were made  
8 from the health care access fund in calendar year 2004 and  
9 before, may not be recommended to pass except by the affirmative  
10 vote of at least three-fifths of all the members of the  
11 committee or division to which the bill has been referred.

12 A new rule 23.7 is added to read:

13 23.7 A bill that includes a transfer of money from the  
14 health care access fund to the general fund, or that includes an  
15 appropriation from the health care access fund for purposes  
16 beyond the scope of those for which appropriations were made  
17 from the health care access fund in calendar year 2004 and  
18 before, may not be recommended to pass except by the affirmative  
19 vote of at least three-fifths of all the members of the Senate.

20 A new Rule 33.6 is added to read:

21 33.6 An amendment to transfer money from the health care  
22 access fund to the general fund, or to appropriate money from  
23 the health care access fund for purposes beyond the scope of  
24 those for which appropriations were made from the health care  
25 access fund in calendar year 2004 and before, may not be adopted  
26 or concurred in except by the affirmative vote of at least  
27 three-fifths of all the members of the Senate.
