Action was taken on the following bills:

1. H.F. 1510 (Weaver); S.F. 1384 (Anderson) - Anoka Firemen's Relief Assn.
Rep. Parish moved that the bill be recommended to pass. Motion carried.
2. H.F. 217 (Bell); S.F. 79 (Ashbach) - Roseville Firemen's Relief Assn.
Sen. Kleinbaum moved that the amendment to strike everything after the enacting clause which will put the Senate file in the same form as the House file be adopted. Motion carried.

(Percy Johnson, Roseville, advised the mill rate in Roseville is 1/10 of a mill)
3. S.F. 925 (G. Perpich) - Chisholm Public Safety Dept. - Sen. Kleinbaum moved that S.F. 925 be recommended to pass. (Moe (no))
4. S.F. 496 (G. Perpich); H.F. 519 (Fugina) - City of Gilbert - Pensions - Police - Rep. Patton moved that the bill be recommended to pass. (Moe (no))
(amendment to change effective date for bill to 12/31/72)
5. S.F. 1615 (Chenoweth - PERA - Sen. Chenoweth went through the bill explaining each section.
